In terms of Section 14 (1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **J S R College of Education, Agraharakkannadiputhur Village, Udumalpet Taluk, Coimbatore - 642204, Tamilnadu** had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for **Secondary(B.Ed)** Course of **One year** from the academic session **2005-06** with an annual intake of **100** students.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:
 - a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - b. The institution will ensure that the permanent building is constructed within a period of 3 years on the acquired land.
 - c. The institution has created an Endowment fund of Rs. 5.00 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 1.00 lakhs.
 - d. The institution has selected the **Principal** and **Seven** teachers for the said course.
3. Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **J S R College of Education, Agraharakkannadiputhur Village, Udumalpet Taluk, Coimbatore - 642204, Tamilnadu** to offer **Secondary(B.Ed)** course of one year duration from the academic session **2005-06** with an annual intake of **100** students, subject to fulfillment of the following.
 - a) The institution will ensure that **Eight(1+7)** exclusive faculty members duly approved by the affiliating university are in position for an intake of **100** students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case before commencement of the course.
 - b) The institution shall shift to its own premises within three years from the date of recognition (in case the course is started in temporary premises).



- c) The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
 - d) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the State Government etc.
 5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating body to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
 6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Southern Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

ORDER

WHEREAS, J.S.R College of Education, Agraharakkannadiputhur Village, Udumalpet Taluk, Coimbatore-642204, Tamilnadu and J.S.R Teacher Training Institute, No. 30, Vadapudhanam Village, Udumalpet Post, Coimbatore District, Pin-642126, Tamilnadu had submitted applications for B.Ed course on 30.12.2004 and D.T.Ed course on 08.12.2005. The institution was granted recognition for B.Ed course on 13.07.2005 with an annual intake of 100 students and D.T.Ed course on 20.06.2007 with an annual intake of 50 students, with the condition to shift to own premises within 3 years.

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide its letter dated 02.11.2010 submitted proposal for shifting of premises. The SRC in its 198th meeting held on 24-26 November, 2010 considered the written request and other documents submitted by the institution and decided to cause composite inspection at the new premises under section 17 of NCTE Act. The institution was directed to submit the certain documents within 30 days of the receipt of the notice, Duly filled in Questionnaire along with all the necessary documents for land, building approval and completion certificate from a competent Govt. Engineer, FDRs for Rs. 5 lakhs and 3 lakhs and other relevant documents. Accordingly, a letter was issued to the institution on 06.01.2011. The inspection of the institution was fixed between 14-19 February, 2011 and was intimated to the institution on 07.02.2011. Accordingly, the inspection of the institution was conducted on 17.02.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 202nd meeting held on 14-15 March 2011 considered the VT Report, VCD and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Show cause Notice under section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly, show cause notice was issued to the institution on 11.04.2011. The institution had submitted its reply on 16.05.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 206th meeting held on 9-10 June 2010 considered the written reply and other documents submitted by the institution and decided to cause re-inspection at the new premises under section 17 of NCTE Act. The institution was again directed to submit the certain documents within 30 days of the receipt of the notice, Demand Draft of Rs.40,000/- inspection fee for each course towards the Teacher Education programme in favour of "The Member Secretary, NCTE" payable at Bangalore.

The inspection of the institution was carried out on 26.07.2011.

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 213th meeting held on 6-7 November, 2011 considered the VT Report, and all the relevant documentary evidences and decided to serve Show cause Notice under section 17 of NCTE Act. Accordingly, a Show cause notice was issued to the institution on 19.12.2011. The institution had submitted its written representation on 12.01.2012.

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AND WHEREAS, the Southern Regional Committee in its 217th Meeting held on 8th to 9th February, 2012 considered the reply of the institution vide letter dt. 12.01.2012 and all other relevant documentary evidence and decided to allow for shifting of the institution to the new premises.

AND WHEREAS, as per the decision of SRC, a permission order for shifting was issued to the institution vide F.No.APS04219 / B.Ed /TN/2011-12/APS04492-D.T.Ed / 39239 dated 14.03.2012.

AND WHEREAS, on 17.03.2012, the institution has submitted a written representation stating as under ;

'I hereby request you to withdraw the recognition granted to our JSR Teacher Training Institute (APS04492 – D.T.Ed) from the academic year 2014-15 and issue the same at the earliest.

'I hereby also request you to issue NOC to release the joint account operated along with NCTE-SRC for the endowment funds of Rs. 5 lakhs and Rs. 3 lakhs created by our JSR Educational and Charitable Trust with Indian Overseas Bank, Udumalpet.'

AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 268th meeting held on 04th-05th June 2014, considered the Institutions request for closure of D.T.Ed-AI course and decided to permit the closure by withdrawing the recognition for (APS04492) D.T.Ed course with effect from 2014-2015, in order to enable the ongoing batch of students in D.T.Ed, course, if any, to complete their final year course.

AND WHEREAS, but it is made clear that the institution is debarred from making any further admission subsequent to the date of issue of this order.


AND WHEREAS, the Affiliating body / Examining board / body be informed accordingly

AND WHEREAS, further decided to return Endowment funds and Reserve fund deposited with SRC NCTE, Bangalore. If any, after ensuring settlement of all faculty and staff claims.

NOW THEREFORE, the recognition accorded to **J.S.R Teacher Training Institute, No. 30, Vadapudhanam Village, Udumalpet Post, Coimbatore District, Pin-642126, Tamilnadu** for D.T.Ed (APS04492) is hereby **withdrawn** as per the request of the institution from the academic year 2014-2015.

WHEREAS, recognition was granted to JSR College of Education, Agraharakannadiputhur Village, Madhathukulam post & Taluk, Tirupur District-642113, Tamil Nadu for B.Ed course with an annual intake of 100 students, vide this office order No F. No.APSO4219/B.Ed/TN/2011-12/39239 dated 14.03.2012.

AND WHEREAS, on the basis of the affidavit submitted by them on 23.02.2015, a revised Recognition Order was issued vide F.No.SRO/NCTE/APS04219/B.Ed/TN/2014-15/62617 dated 18.03.2015.

AND WHEREAS, the institution submitted written representation on 03.11.2015 requesting therein for reduction of strength from 2 units to 1 unit in its B.Ed course.

AND WHEREAS, the request was placed before SRC in its 343rd meeting held on 1st to 2nd August, 2017 and the Committee considered the matter and decided as under:-

1. The request for reduction from 2 units to 1 unit is accepted subject to the following conditions:

The request for reduction of intake strength from 2 units to 1 unit is accepted subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The reduction will be w.e.f. 2017-18. The students admitted into the 2 units in 2016-17 will however be entitled to continue with and complete their 2nd year course in 2017-18.
- (ii) Admissions in 2017-18 will be limited to one unit of 50. The affiliating Universities will please ensure that this is strictly observed.
- (iii) Notwithstanding the restriction of admission in the first year course to 50, there will be no reduction in the faculty strength of 1+15, as prescribed in the 2014 Regulations because of the continuing workload in the 2nd year course. The affiliating Universities will please ensure that this is strictly observed.
- (iv) The faculty strength can be reduced to 1+9 w.e.f. 2018-19.

This arrangement will come into force with immediate effect because of the urgency of admissions relating to proximity of counseling. But, it will be subject to subsequent production of the under listed documents by the institutions concerned.

- (i) Resolution of the sponsoring society.
- (ii) NOC of the Affiliating University.
- (iii) No Dues Certificate relating to the Teaching faculty.
- (iv) No Dues Certificate relating to the non-Teaching Faculty.

2. These cases will be processed for RPRO purposes separately, subsequently.
3. Issue order for the reduction of strength accordingly and resubmit for RPRO processing.

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NOW THEREFORE, the request of the institution for reduction of intake from 2 units to 1 unit in the B.Ed course is permitted herewith subject to the conditions indicated in the above para and fulfillment of the conditions mentioned vide F.No.SRO/NCTE/APS04219/B.Ed/TN/2014-15/62617 dated 18.03.2015.

ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution, namely **J S R College of Education, Agraharakkannadiputhur Village, Madhathukuam Post & Taluk, Tirurpur District-642113, Tamilnadu** run by **J.S.R. Educational and Charitable Trust, 11/37, Nehru Street, Samarayapatti Post, Udumalpet Taluk, Coimbatore District, Tamilnadu-642204** for conducting Secondary (B.Ed.) course of one year duration with an intake of 100 students on 13.07.2005 with a condition that the institution shall shift to its own premises within 3 years from the date of recognition.

2. AND WHEREAS, the Tamilnadu Teachers Education University had forwarded a copy of show cause notice issued to the institution for not functioning in accordance with the conditions stipulated by the NCTE, SRC, Bangalore and Tamilnadu Teachers Education University as could be apprehended from the report of Inspection commission which caused a surprise visit to the colleges.

3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 217th meeting held on 08th & 09th February 2012 considered the reply of the institution vide letter dt. 12.01.2012 and all other relevant documentary evidence and decided to allow for shifting of the institution to the new premises.

4. AND WHEREAS, an order was issued on dt. 14.03.2012 granting permission to shift its premises to the new location/building at "**Agraharakkannadiputhur Village, Madhathukulam Post and Taluk, Tirupur District, Pin-642113, Tamilnadu.**"

5. AND WHEREAS, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by a notarized affidavit dt. 29.01.2015 consented to come under new Regulations.

6. AND WHEREAS, the SRC (NCTE) issued the revised provisional recognition order dt. 18.03.2015 to **J S R College of Education, Agraharakkannadiputhur Village, Madhathukuam Post & Taluk, Tirurpur District-642113, Tamilnadu** for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (2 basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016 subject to fulfilment of conditions mentioned therein.

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7. AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dt. 21.12.2016 has requested for reduction of intake from 2 units to 1 unit. The SRC in its 343rd meeting considered the request and permitted to reduce the intake from 2 units to 1 unit. Accordingly, an order was issued for granting 1 unit of B.Ed. vide order dt. 12.09.2017.

8. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 381st meeting considered the matter and decided to issue Show Cause Notice to all the institution where RPRO was issued and they did not submit their compliance so far. Accordingly, a Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on dt. 21.01.2020. The reply of the institution submitted on dt. 10.02.2020 in respect of SCN issued was considered by the SRC in its 386th meeting wherein the SRC decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice and the FSCN was issued to the institution on dt. 04.08.2020. The institution submitted its reply of FSCN dt. 04.08.2020 vide letter dt. 08.08.2020.

9. AND WHEREAS, the matter was placed before the SRC in its 388th meeting held on 14th 15th September, 2020 considered and decided as the following grounds:

“The original files of the Institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made: -

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution vide letter dt. 08.08.2020, the Committee decided that the **continuation order** be issued to the Institution **J.S.R. College of Education, Tirupur District – 642113, Tamil Nadu** for B.Ed programme for **1 basic unit of 50 students.**”

10. NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **J.S.R. College of Education, Agraharakkannadiputhur Village, S.F. No.121,122/A1, A2, Madathukulam Taluk, Tirupur District – 638204, Tamilnadu** for continuation of recognition for B.Ed. course programme for **1 basic unit of 50 students** subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

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- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
11. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc as applicable.
12. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
13. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-
- a. Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter;
 - d. Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e. Fee charged from students;
 - f. Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
14. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
15. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
16. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Southern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.

Also order that a copy of this Order be published in the official Gazette.
